# New models for the provision of legal services in the hunt for value

The focus on value and value-based billing from general counsel, the return of law firm mega-mergers and legislative change particularly in the UK to allow outside investment in law firms will only speed this up.

With the almost unprecedented pace of regulatory reform worldwide, multinationals are under increasing pressure to mount robust internal investigations very quickly.
